THE PURPOSE OF THIS SPECIAL CALLED MEETING IS TO DISCUSS THE CITY OF
BREMEN'S HARALSON COUNTY SPLOST PROJECTS LIST

Mayor Sewell called the special meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Mayor Sewell stated that Haralson County Commissioners have decided to put a Level II SPLOST Project on the ballot in November for the purpose of building a county jail. Should the referendum pass, Haralson County will get 20% off the top. The cities will receive zero dollars for the first year of this SPLOST being in affect.

The five year period for this SPLOST will run from April 2015 through March 2020. The county has not provided any cost estimates for the jail project. They simply say that they do not yet know the cost. There also has been no land purchased for the jail site at this time. There is no plan in place for the facility.

City Manager Perry Hicks stated that after the county takes 20% off the top, the rest would be split between the county and the cities. Bremen's portion would be approximately 3.1 million dollars over the entire SPLOST period. He read over the list of capital projects that has been put together using the Department Head requests and looking at the needs of the city.

There was discussion among the Mayor and Council and the City Manger regarding the debt projects.

Council Member Sonny Parrish made a motion to accept the list of projects as presented by the City Manager. Council Member Jane Wilson seconded the motion to accept the projects list as presented and the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Sewell asked for a motion to adjourn the Special Called Council Meeting.

A motion by Council Member Parrish was made to adjourn the special called meeting at 10:30 a.m.
