Purpose of Special Called Meeting

The purpose of this Special Called Meeting was to discuss the proposed Haralson County TSPLOST referendum.

Call to Order

Mayor Sewell called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

TSPLOST

Perry Hicks handed out a list of the city's possible TSPLOST projects for the period of April 1, 2018 thru March 31, 2023 and stated that the estimated collection is \$12,000,000 and the City of Bremen would receive 21.45% of the total collection, which would be \$2,574,000 over the 5-year period.

The list of projects on the list totaled \$3,281,850, which is \$707,850 more than the estimated 21.45% that the city would receive.

Mayor Sewell and Council Members along with Perry Hicks and Mike Thompson discussed which items on the list could possibly be removed in order to get our projects list down to the estimated amount that the City of Bremen would receive.

The final list of proposed City of Bremen projects includes Bridge & Drainage projects \$475,000, Pedestrian Sidewalks, Paths & Trails \$942,150, Parking Improvements \$225,000, Paving, Re-surfacing, Traffic Control Devices and Related Work \$931,850 which totals the estimated amount in which Bremen would receive at 21.45% of the total collections.

Mayor Sewell asked for a motion to approve the proposed Haralson County TSPLOST agreement.

Council Member Thomason made a motion to approve the proposed Haralson County TSPLOST agreement. Council Member Otwell seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Adjourn

Council Member Thomason made a motion to adjourn the special called meeting and the meeting was adjourned at 7:15 pm.
