REVIEW & MODIFICATION OF THE AGENDA

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mayor Sewell asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the July 17, 2023 regular council meeting.

2023 PROPERTY TAX MILLAGE ORDINANCES

City Manager, Perry Hicks stated that the proposed millage rate for the Haralson County portion of Bremen is 4,733 which is a decrease from last year and the proposed millage rate for the Carroll County portion of Bremen is 6.884 which is also a decrease from last year. He stated that we have advertised the current and five-year history as required but we were not required to hold the public hearings since we lowered our millage rates.

Mayor Sewell asked if there is a motion to approve the City of Bremen / Haralson millage ordinance for 2023 tax year.

Council Member Thomason made a motion that was seconded by Council Member Harris to approve the City of Bremen / Haralson millage ordinance for tax year 2023 at 4.733 mills. The motion carried.

Mayor Sewell asked if there is a motion to approve the City of Bremen / Carroll millage ordinance for 2023 tax year.

A motion was made by Council Member Harris to approve the 2023 City of Bremen / Carroll millage ordinance at 6,884 mills as presented. Council Member Thomason seconded the motion and the motion carried.
